

### 1.1.1 Getting to Tallinn

#### **By Air**

There are direct flights or connections to Tallinn from many European cities.

[Lennart Meri Tallinn Airport](http://www.tallinn-airport.ee/eng) (<http://www.tallinn-airport.ee/eng>) terminal is only 4 km from the city centre and it provides a wide variety of services.

From the airport you can take Bus no. 2 to the city centre. Buses run every 20 minutes from 7.00 am until 12 midnight between the airport, the city centre and the port, stopping in front of the Arrivals Hall. There is also a taxi rank in front of the Arrivals Hall.

#### **By Sea**

Ferries cross the Gulf of Finland between Tallinn and Helsinki several times a day. Hydrofoils and jet cats also run from late spring to late autumn.

Ferries to Stockholm leave every other evening and the trip takes approximately 15 hours. The ferry terminals are located within walking distance of the Old Town.

From the port you can take bus no. 2 to the city centre. Tallinn University is within walking distance of the city centre.

#### **By Bus**

From the bus station you can take bus no. 17 or tram no. 4 or 2 to the city centre. Tallinn University is within walking distance of the city centre.

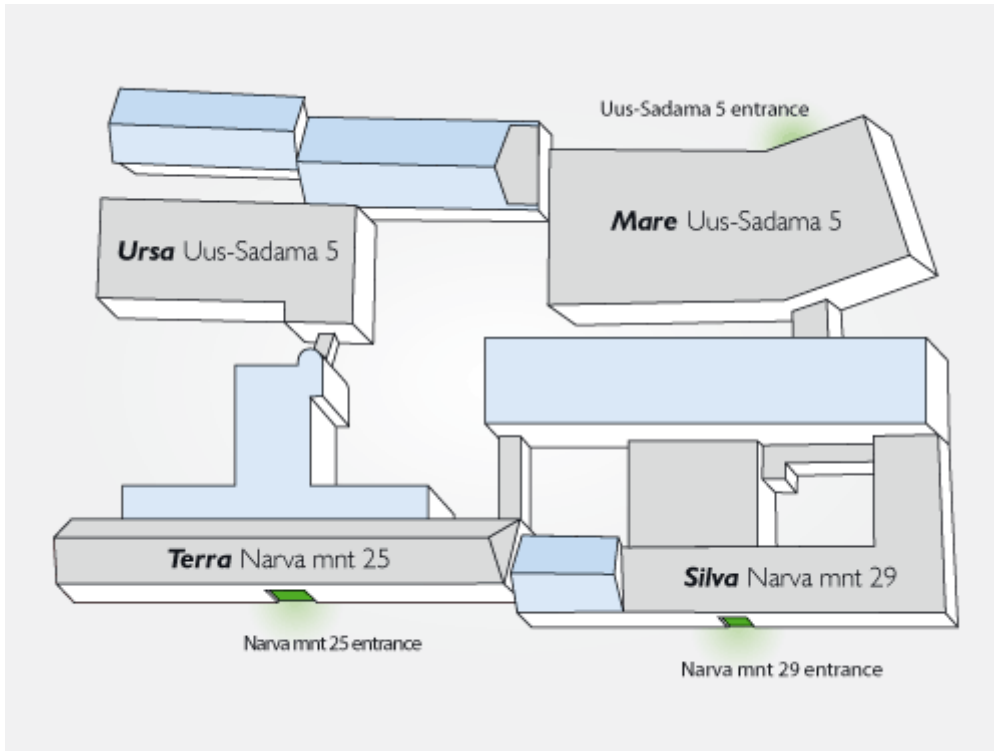
